

Explore the 90 Mile Genesee Valley Greenway with a New Historic Interpretive Hike Series



The series will take place over two years and will include all 14 hikes in the Wegmans Passport to Wellness Program, an initiative launched on I Love My Park Day 2014 to get people outdoors and active. Guides will provide history of the Genesee Valley Greenway and incorporate history of the town in which the hike is located, in addition to pointing out interesting natural and historic features along the way.

The schedule of the first year of hikes is:

Hike 1 - April 11th at 10:00 a.m.

Genesee Valley Park South (Wegmans Hike Number 1)

Park in Genesee Valley Park off of Scottsville Rd. (near pool and boat house). Meet at the Trail Head for the Genesee Valley Greenway and Riverway Trail. (2.5 miles)

Hike 2 - May 9th at 10:00 a.m.

Brook Road to Black Creek (Wegmans Hike Number 2)

Park at the Brook Road Parking Area, off of Brook Road in the Town of Chili. Meet in the Parking Area. (3.7 miles)

Hike 3 - June 13th at 10:00 a.m.

York Landing North (Wegmans Hike Number 6)

Park at York Landing Parking Area off of York Landing Road in the Town of York. Meet at the Information Kiosk. (3.1 miles)

Hike 4 - July 11th at 10 a.m.

Mt. Morris to Genesee River (Wegmans Hike Number 8)

Park at Rt. 408 (East State Street) Parking Area in the Village of Mt. Morris. Meet in the Parking Area. (2.2 miles)

Hike 5 - August 8th at 10:00 a.m.

Oakland Road to County Rt. 20 (Wegmans Hike Number 10)

Park at Oakland Road in the Hamlet of Oakland. Meet in the Parking Area. (2 miles)

Hike 6 - September 12th at 10:00 a.m.

Rockville Dam to Huck Road (Wegmans Hike Number 12)

Park at the Rockville Lake Dam at the End of Lake Road (Formerly Havens Road) in the Town of Belfast. Meet at the Trailhead. (2.1 miles)

Hike 7 - October 10th at 10:00 a.m.

Bull Street to West Cuba Road (Wegmans Hike Number 14)

Park on the West Side of Bull Street in the Town of Cuba (near the gazebo). Meet at the Gazebo. (2.7 miles)
